

This legislation has been introduced by Senator Brenner and should appear before the Maine Legislative Council March 21, 2023. We understand that the Legislative Council will discuss and make a decision “yea” or “nay”. If yea, the resolution goes first to the Chamber of the sponsor i.e. Senator Brenner would have it go to the Senate. (It does not go to a committee first). If passed, it goes to the House. If both Chambers pass it, the Resolution has passed. No further action needed. (follow [notes all the way to the bottom](#) to view where LR #803 was posted)

### LR # 803 summary of any point that you can emphasize and why:

- First Use: prevent nuclear war by renouncing the option to use nuclear weapons first,
- Sole Authority: ending the sole, unchecked authority of the president to launch a nuclear attack,
- Off HairTrigger alert :taking United States nuclear weapons off hair-trigger alert,
- Cancel nuclear escalation: canceling the plan to replace the country’s entire arsenal with enhanced weapons and
- Support TPNW: actively pursuing a verifiable agreement among nuclear-armed states to eliminate their nuclear arsenals;
