

Pax Christi Call: Please join us to vigil and rally on Saturday, Jan. 11, 2025 at 1:00 -2:00, to mark the 23rd year anniversary of the Guantanamo Bay prison. We will vigil in front of the Augusta National Guard Armory, at the intersection of Route 202 and Armory Street, and then rally with speakers, singers and more.

Our message is simple: **Shut Down Guantanamo**. According to the ACLU, since the prison opened in 2002, 780 prisoners have been held there, including 21 children. More than 86% of those prisoners were sold as prisoners to the U.S. for a bounty. Currently, 15 remain imprisoned at Guantanamo, 6 of whom have never been charged with any crime or offense and are held indefinitely, in violation of international law. Adding to their injury, **3 of these 6 have been approved for release but are still held.**" https://paxchristi-maine
